Ø The proposed amendments to the Towns Land Use Bylaw (Bylaw 2024-12) are amending the Downtown Commercial (CD) District to include a Gas Bar as a discretionary use, adding discretionary to Downtown Commercial (CD) District signs by land Use District Chart C4.1 Delete Section C4.5(1) that states to reduce visual clutter, all business shall be limited to one (1) permanent sign, one (1) temporary sign, and one window sign.
